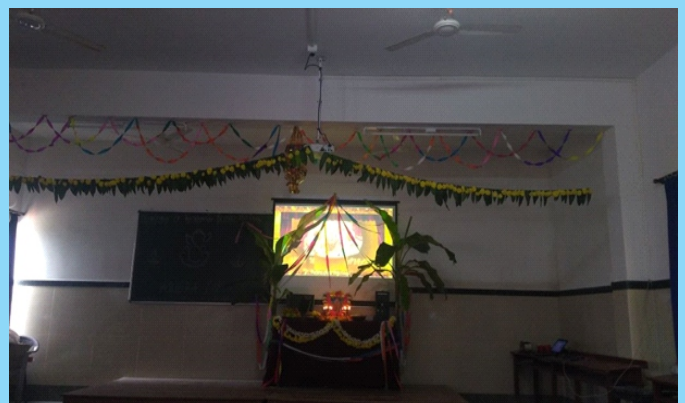
WORKSHOP ON IoT
