

In this closely contested event, the AIML G section secured the first place with their innovative presentation. They were followed by the CSE B section, who earned the second place with their impressive display of creative abilities.

Activities of Student Welfare Department

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- Students of E and F Sections (ISE & AIML) of Batch 2023-24 (1st year) were addressed by Ms. Sandhya on Counseling for students What, why & when. She enlightened students on the needs and benefits of counseling. Each section had a one hour session on 5th October, 2023.
- Sessions on student psychology were conducted for the Batch of 2023-24 on 4th, 5th and 6th of October, 2023. Mrs. Rikitha Pais, a PG in Psychological Sciences (St. Agnes College, Mangalore) addressed the students on "Wellness in Teenagers", covering topics like Introduction about teenagers, features and concerns of the teenage period, risk taking behaviour of teenagers, techniques to promote mental health in teenagers, including Stress Management and conflict resolution techniques. The sessions were well appreciated by the students.
- Mr. Gunapala Gowda J., PSI, Vigilance Sub division and Police Station, Mangalore, addressed the students of 1st year Engineering on 16th August, 2023 on Anti-ragging, Drug free campus, Cyber crime, Online frauds, Traffic rules and related laws. The event was organized in observance of the Anti-Ragging week from 12th August, 2023 to 18th August, 2023 as initiated by AICTE. Mr. Gunapala, drove home a strong message on ensuring a campus free of the menaces of ragging and drug abuse very effectively citing incidents and explaining related laws. He urged students not to be trapped into the use of drugs for reasons of failures in life. Students should weigh the pros and cons of every situation, analyze and learn from both good and bad, he said. Regarding Anti-ragging, Mr. Gunapala cited various Sections under the Indian Penal Code (IPC) - Sec 294, Sec 339, Sec 340 in case of non-violent cases and Sec 323, Sec 324, Sec 325 and Sec 326 in case of violent cases, terming the crime as a cognizable offence and warning students that indulging in such activities may wreak havoc to their careers. Two documentaries on Anti-ragging were also played during the session. The PSI also gave a brief insight to the students on trending cyber-crimes, online frauds and traffic rules giving relevant examples from his experience as a Police officer. The session concluded with Mr. Gunapala, giving a sneak peek into how his passion for service has led him from being a Mechanical Engineer to being an IPS officer.









T.I.M.E. Institute in Mangalore conducted two sessions for 1st and 2nd year students on "Orientation on higher studies after Engineering". The speaker Mr. Ganesh Hebbar, Centre Director at T.I.M.E. - Mangalore / Udupi addressed the students and enlightened them on the different exams available after Engineering to make them eligible for Post Graduation. His presentation included details of exams like GRE, GATE, CAT, MAT, XAT and the like. He also explained the pros and cons of getting into government and private sector jobs. Two sessions were conducted for II year - CSE, ISE and ME and 1st year CSE - Sec A from 2:00 to 3:00 PM and for II year - CSBS, CSD, and ECE and I year - CSE, Sec B and AIML, Sec E. The students appreciated the program.







The Department of Science and Humanities organized a technical talk on "Recent Developments in Software Technology" for first-year A and B section students on 2nd August , 2023. The resource person for this session was Prof. Alok Ranjan from the Department of Computer Science and Engineering. Department vision, mission, Programme outcomes were explained to the students. Types of courses, number of courses. Head of department explained the students about NBA process for accreditation. Importance of accreditation, Types of accreditation. Role of students in accreditation process etc. Students were introduced different laboratories, research centres by respective department. 






Cultural Activity:

Cultural activity was conducted for newly joined BE students on 12th September ,2023. Students were divided into 10 sections based on their chosen programme. In each section, students were asked to form 4 groups. Each group was given a time of 45 minutes. to prepare for any cultural activities like singing, dancing, group singing, group dancing, mime, skit with a theme. After scheduled time, each group performed for a period of 15 minutes in the class room stage. One faculty member is assigned to monitor the students and asked to judge the group. Each student showed their talents and participated enthusiastically.







Poster Making Competition:

Poster Making competition is conducted for newly joined BE students. Students were divided into 10 sections based on their chosen Programme. Students were asked to bring A3 drawing sheets, crayons, pencil, and eraser whatever required drawing poster/pencil sketch well in advance. Students were permitted to do the sketches individually. One faculty member is assigned to monitor the event in each section.







Session on "Introduction to syllabus, scheme, evaluation methods"

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






Session on "ISHA Hatha Yoga":
