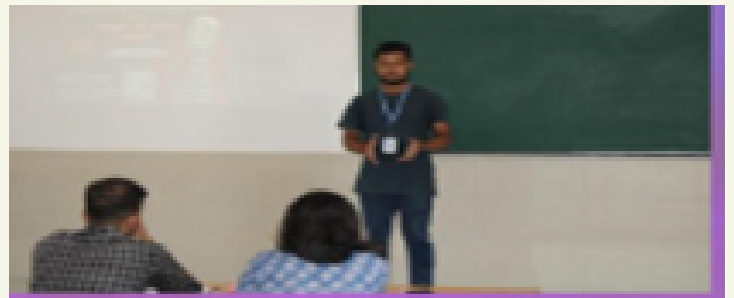
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES IN CEC

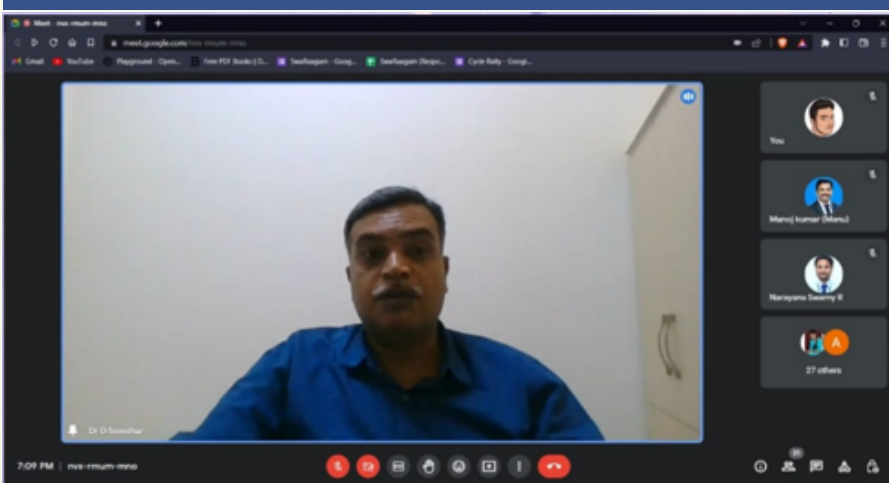

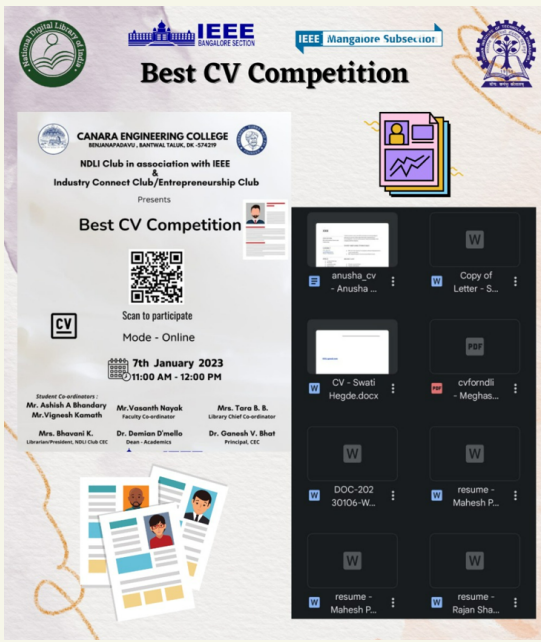
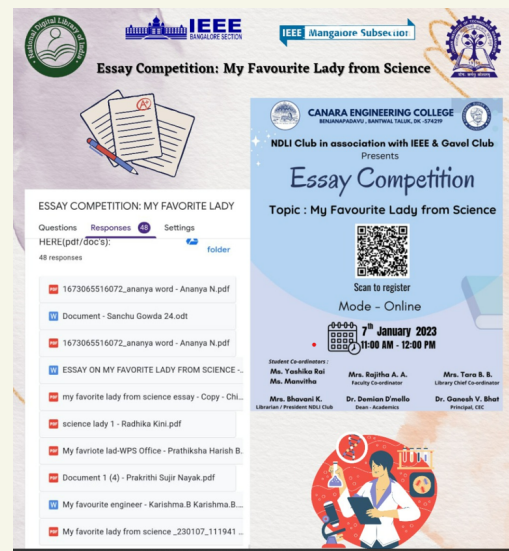
